**Registration Information:** 2018 MAFCA Membership is required to attend the National Awards Event. Registration will be open on Tuesday afternoon from 12 to 5 PM and on Wednesday morning from 8 AM to 12 Noon.

#### Please note that the registration fee is <u>per couple or individual</u>. The events for each day and Banquet fees are <u>per person</u>.

In order to print or fill out the forms on your computer, you will need to open them with a recent version of the free program Adobe Reader® (either Adobe Reader® DC, or version 7.0 or later of the old Adobe Reader®). Be sure to save the forms to your computer (right-click on the forms and choose either "save link as" or "save target as", depending on your browser). Otherwise, if you read the forms in your browser, they may not display correctly and the calculations may not work. If you fill out the forms with Adobe Reader® before printing, the totals will be calculated automatically. If you don't already have Adobe Reader®, or if you want to upgrade to the latest version, you can download it at <a href="https://get.adobe.com/reader">https://get.adobe.com/reader</a> (be sure to uncheck the optional add-ons that you don't want before starting the download). The forms will also be available in *The Restorer* magazine if you don't have a computer. If you fill them out by hand, please make them as legible as possible so that we won't need to contact you for clarification. Don't forget to identify an emergency contact with a phone number, and all participants must sign and date the Waiver form.

The hotel does not offer shuttle service to or from the airport. It is recommended that either Uber or Lyft or a taxi be utilized. Uber and Lyft drivers are stationed at the airport and are less expensive than a taxi, but require that either the Uber or Lyft app be installed on your phone. One-way costs range from \$20-\$25 for Uber or Lyft and \$30-\$35 for a taxi.

Limited (No Fee) Truck/Trailer/RV parking will be available in the lot in the rear of the hotel. Please indicate on the registration form if you are planning to drive or trailer your Model A to the event. That information will be helpful for telling the hotel how many Model A and truck/trailer/RV parking spots we will need and to help us plan for a Model A support team (trouble trailer) if needed. RVs are welcome to park overnight in the rear parking lot at the hotel, but there are no hookups and no overnight stays in RVs allowed on the hotel property.

RV Parking with hookups is available at Far Horizons RV Park, 555 Pantano Rd, 520-296-1234 (about 1.2 miles from the hotel). Call for availability. Many other RV parks are along I-10, and are 5-30 miles from the hotel.

Area Restaurants: The hotel has a shuttle that is limited to a three-mile radius. The hotel has more information on other restaurants on the east side and in downtown Tucson, but will require using Uber/Lyft or a taxi.

### MAFCA 2018 National Awards Banquet November 27 - December 1, 2018



The Tucson Model A Club cordially invites you to the 2018 MAFCA National Awards Banquet in Tucson. We have planned excursions to two world-class museums and a genuine cowboy cookout for you to enjoy. Registration will be open on Tuesday afternoon from 12 to 5 PM and on Wednesday morning from 8 AM to 12 Noon. Don't forget to purchase some 50/50 drawing tickets while registering, and be sure to check out the items in the "Bucket Raffle" room. The Hospitality room will open that afternoon and will be open every day during the event.

We have a "meet and greet" reception planned with a cash bar and club-hosted hors d'oeuvres on Tuesday evening. Dinner will be on your own. The hotel has a newly remodeled restaurant, and there are many restaurants on the east side of town and in downtown Tucson.

On Wednesday morning we will have three tech sessions; the first will be a presentation by MAFCA, titled *Vehicle Judging Moves into the 21st Century*. The second will feature a presentation on the long history of Tucson's Birthplace", a local historical society. The third will be on *How to Choose the Right Spark Plug for Your Model A*, by Howard Eckstein. This seminar looks at the engineering requirements of the Model A spark plug and the driving conditions that contribute to plug failure and success. An era fashion exhibition room will also will be open in the morning.



After lunch on your own, the Tucson Club President will offer a tour of his eclectic auto collection of over 100 cars, trucks, fire engines and many other unique autos. Bus transportation will be provided.



Wednesday evening features a "Cowboy Cookout" at the world-renowned Tanque Verde Ranch. The BBQ meal is complete with steaks, ribs, cornbread, fresh fruit and a variety of desserts, while listening to live authentic cowboy-themed music. Bus transportation will be provided. Attendees may drive their Model A's out to the ranch, about 10 miles east of Tucson. A Tucson Club member will lead the Model A group.

The MAFCA Board meeting is scheduled all day Wednesday, and any registrant can attend (the board will also have a closed session around 3 PM).

On Thursday we will provide bus transportation to the Pima Air & Space Museum, one of the largest privately funded aviation and space museums in the world. It contains over 300 commercial and military aircraft, from a Wright Flyer to a 787 Dreamliner. Lunch will be on your own at the museum. It is a short drive for those with Model A's, with a Tucson Club member leading the way. Thursday evening dinner is on your own.





Friday we have scheduled a bus to the Arizona-Sonora Desert Museum, a "top 10" U.S. museum 25 miles west of Tucson. The majority of the museum is outdoors and includes most all of the plants, fish and animals native to the Sonoran Desert. Lunch will be on your own at the museum.

The bus trip to and from the museum will take you over roads which feature a magnificent view of the giant Saguaro cactus, which is unique to the Sonoran Desert. Attendees driving Model A's are welcome to follow a Tucson Club member on a scenic Saguaro drive out to the museum and back to the hotel.

Friday evening's main event is the Awards Banquet, with a no-host Happy Hour at the hotel. Saturday is checkout day, and you will be able to pick up raffle items that morning.

1. THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE MAFCA, ITS CHAPTERS, REGIONS OR SPECIAL INTEREST GROUPS, THEIR EMPLOYEES, OFFICERS AND AGENTS ("Releasees") from all liability to the undersigned, his or her or their personal representatives, assigns, heirs, family members and next of kin ("Releasors") for any loss, damage, or claim therefor on account of injury to the person or property of the Releasors, whether caused by any negligent act or omission or other fault of the Releasees or otherwise while the undersigned is participating in the Event or using any of Releasees' facilities in connection with the Event.

2. THE RELEASORS HEREBY AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS the Releasees from all liability, claims, demands, causes of action, charges, expenses, and attorney fees and all other costs resulting from involvement in the Event whether caused by any negligent act or omission or other fault of the Releasees or otherwise.

3. THE RELEASORS HEREBY ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND RISK OF PERSONAL OR BODILY INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE while upon Releasee property or participating in the Event or using any Releasee facilities and/or equipment whether caused by any negligent act or omission or other fault of Releasees or otherwise. # Other Attractions and Places to Visit

If you come early or stay late, here are some attractions in and around Tucson and Southern Arizona that you may enjoy:



**Sabino Canyon:** Take a tram through Sabino Canyon and you will witness the Catalina Mountains up close and personal. Experience the beauty of one of the most unique Southwestern desert canyons on a Sabino Canyon tram ride. Sabino Canyon is a natural desert oasis located in Tucson's Coronado National Forest and is home to spectacular desert landscapes and abundant wildlife including Palo Verde trees, Cholla and Prickly Pear cactus and graceful groves of Ocotillo cactus. **Titan II Missile Museum:** During the Cold War, Davis-Monthan Air Force Base was considered a strategic target, and Tucson was ringed by underground silos containing Titan II missiles. Only one remains and was converted to a museum open to the public. It is located about 10 miles south of Tucson in the town of Sahuarita. Visit their website at <u>www.titanmissilemuseum.org</u> for location and information on tours and hours.



**Biosphere 2:** Originally constructed with private funds to test the effects of long term isolation mimicking space travel, the facility was later acquired by the University of Arizona and was converted into a unique environmental testing laboratory housing seven model enclosed ecosystems with active research by teams of multidisciplinary scientists. Visit <u>www.biosphere2.org</u> for more information.



**Tombstone:** The "Town Too Tough to Die" is located about an hour's drive southeast of Tucson. Tombstone is known for its Wild West history. On historic Allen Street, the O.K. Corral outdoor theater re-enacts the historic 1881 "Gunfight at the O.K. Corral" which made Wyatt Earp famous. Resident ghosts are said to haunt the bullet-riddled Bird Cage Theatre. Outlaws are among the local townsfolk buried at the 1878 Boot Hill Cemetery, and exhibits at the Tombstone Courthouse State Historic Park include a replica gallows. **Bisbee:** Once a thriving mining town said to have been the largest between St. Louis and San Francisco in the 1880's, it has morphed into an artist's village with a fabulous mining museum showcasing the history of Bisbee. Attractions include the abandoned Lavender open pit copper mine and an underground mine tour. There are also several places to eat. Bisbee is located about 2 hours southeast of Tucson and about 30 minutes from Tombstone. More information is available at www.discoverbisbee.com.



**Mount Lemmon:** Take a drive up the Mount Lemmon Highway and you will experience a major change in climate, from the flora and fauna of the Sonoran Desert landscape with a variety of desert dwellers at the bottom to a ponderosa pine forest that is home to black bear, deer, and a population of bighorn sheep at the top. Located just an hour's drive from the sun-drenched city of Tucson, the drive up the mountain offers an impressive variety of views of the Tucson valley and the surrounding mountains. There are many vista points along the way that offer the opportunity to take photos. The highway is paved and suitable for passenger vehicles. It is occasionally closed in the winter due to snow, so it is advisable to check the most current road conditions by calling the Pima County Sheriff's 24-hour Road Condition Hotline at 520-547-7510 (year round).

**Wayne's Toys:** For the car enthusiast, a visit to the indoor car collection of Wayne Gould in downtown Tucson is a must. He has a unique collection of cars, both American and Foreign, displayed in a 50's setting. Visit his website at <u>www.waynestoys.com</u> for more information, hours and location.

**Franklin Car Museum:** Another unique collection of Franklin cars and Indian artifacts is located at the home of the late Tucson resident Tom Hubbard. Check out the Franklin Car Museum website at <u>www.franklinmuseum.org</u> for hours and directions.

**Boneyard Tour:** Take a bus tour of the 309th Aerospace Maintenance and Regeneration Group (AMARG, also known as the "Boneyard") on the Davis-Monthan Air Force Base, adjacent to the Pima Air & Space Museum. This is the world's largest military storage and salvage yard. New security restrictions require advance reservations. A request must be submitted for the tour at least 10 business days prior to your arrival in Tucson.
