

Titan Missile Museum Outing

November 23, 2025

Unfortunately the ASARCO Mine Tour was canceled for November, so fifteen members of the Model A/Model T Clubs trekked down to Jerry Bobs in Green Valley/Sahuarita on November 23, some from as far as Hereford and Elgin for a delicious and filling breakfast and a tour of the Titan Missile Museum.

After lively discussion at breakfast, ten members drove on a not so scenic route through a parking lot (David made a wrong turn) over to the Titan Missile Museum for either a surface tour or a below ground tour of the last remaining Titan II underground missile launch site in the USA.

The above ground museum was a lesson and a reminder of the Cold War history many of us lived through. The underground tour was just as interesting with the explanation of how the crews worked 24 hour shifts and the strict procedures required to change crews when their shifts ended.

We then took a look at a decommissioned Titan II missile sitting in its silo as if ready to launch. Very impressive.

Two Model A's, a Model T and 6 modern cars/trucks made the trip without any issues. Everyone had an enjoyable time as we missed all the rain south of Tucson around 1PM!


