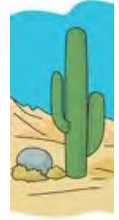

## **HF Coors Factory Tour and Lunch**

February 11, 2026

On Feb. 11, 2026 Model A and T members met at HF Coors to take a tour of their factory. Members brought 5 vintage cars and 21 members participated in the tour. Greg Goodman, the manager, led us through the processes that are needed to manufacture dinnerware, ornaments, and other pottery items. Our first stop was to where the clay is made from dry materials and added water, and other materials. The clay is then squeezed into presses to release all liquid. The clay is then pressed into cylinder shapes and taken to another room where the clay is pressed by molds to form the dinnerware pieces. From there the pieces dry and excess clay pieces are removed and the bottoms are shaved smooth. Items requiring glaze or decals are applied and all is then fired in the biggest conveyor belt kiln I have ever seen. Some items such as pitchers and ornaments have the clay poured into molds and they are then glazed, decalated, etc, and go to the kiln. I may have left a process out or they may be slightly out of order, but this was the best to my recollection. There was a lot to see and hear. We all learned a lot.

After the tour 15 members traveled to BJ's Restaurant for lunch.

A very good time was had by all.


